Here are a few tips to assist in selecting the correct size

- Take measurements in the socks that will be used while skating
- Stand on a sheet of paper.
- Have someone else place a mark at your longest toe and at your heel. The pen should be straight up and down to determine the proper length.
- Remove the foot and measure the distance between both marks in inches; repeat with your second foot.
- Using the longer measurement of your two feet, select the most appropriate size. Do not select a size that is smaller than the length of your longest foot.
- To find your width, measure all the way around the widest part of the front of your foot (ball of the foot).

Please Note:

- Do not use shoe size as a reference, skates and shoes are sized differently.
- Children may need a little extra room for growth.
